

## **Parkinson Association of Alberta Step 'n Stride 2021**

### Fundraiser contest

## Contest Rules and Regulations

**1. CONTEST PERIOD:** For this contest, the contest period is 12 a.m. on Tuesday, June 1, 2021 to 11:59 p.m. on Friday, Sept. 17, 2021.

**2. ELIGIBILITY:** This contest is open to all legal residents of Canada, who are at least eighteen (18) years of age or older as of the first day of the contest period. The contest is not open to individuals associated with the contest, including the employees, agents or representatives of Parkinson Association of Alberta, and suppliers providing prizes or other materials or services in connection with this contest (collectively, the "Excluded Individuals"). This contest is also not open to the immediate family members of the Excluded Individuals, and all other persons with whom the Excluded Individuals reside.

**3. HOW TO ENTER:** To enter for a chance to win a listed prize, entrants must be registered fundraisers for the Parkinson Association of Alberta's Step 'n Stride 2021 event and must raise an amount of \$500.00 for a first entry ticket, and \$250.00 for each additional entry ticket. There is no maximum amount of entry tickets a contest participant can collect. Each ticket allows for one chance in the random draw for the three listed prizes. Draw date for all prizes is Tuesday, Oct. 19, 2021, and will take place at Parkinson Association of Alberta offices.
