Application for Graduate Studentship

To be used to conduct research in Parkinson's disease at an Alberta-based University. Research can be basic or clinical. Candidate may be doing MSc or PhD. For the applicant to qualify, the supervisor must hold a permanent faculty position at a registered Alberta based academic institution.

Submit the following:

- a. Curriculum Vitae of Applicant
- b. Biosketch of Supervisor (NIH format preferred)
- c. Description of project (maximum three pages): suggested headings are Background and Rationale, Objectives, Research Methodology, Timeline (which should refer to graduate program activities that would be completed in the 2-years award period), Projected Impact
- d. Description of resources and support from supervisor (maximum one page): this should include in some detail the local resources that would make the proposed research feasible for the awarded time period

Total amount of award up to \$50,000 (\$25,000/year for 2 years)

Please send an expression of interest (EOI) including your credentials and a brief description of your project no later than Friday, March 29th, 2024. The deadline for full application is Friday, May 31st, 2024 and awards will be announced by August 1st, 2024.
