Brian Farrell Music Inc. helps artists find their signature sound through vocal coaching, innovative workshops, and artistic mentorship.

Farrell's formal education which includes a B.Mus. (Hons.), and B.Ed. from Western University in London, studies at Westminster Choir College at Princeton, the University of Michigan and an M.A. from San Diego State University set the stage for his 40-year career.

Brian is the founder of "Turntable Creative Class", a performance showcase for artists that he and music manager Neil MacGonigill host. Producer/drummer Ashwin Sood and Brian developed "The Reboot Lab", a workshop to help musicians navigate the current business of music and hone their musical skills.
